## What is CLEAR?

## COVID-19 Learning, Evidence and Research (CLEAR) for Bangladesh

• A **2.5 year long program** to generate new policy-relevant research that will support COVID-19 recovery and increase resilience to future shocks in Bangladesh

#### G CLEAR will:

- Deliver policy relevant COVID-19 research and evidence tailored to Bangladesh;
- Promote evidence uptake for policy and programming
- Learn lessons from the COVID-19 response to better prepare for future shocks.
- CLEAR is funded by the UK Government's Foreign Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) and coordinated by the Institute of Development Studies. BRAC Institute for Governance and Development (BIGD) is supporting the design of the research agenda and policy engagement activities




# **CLEAR Components**

The core activities of the programme are divided under **three interconnected components**:

- multidisciplinary research and evidence
- o policy engagement
- learning

  - ii. Competitive call for proposals

# **CLEAR Components**

## **Component 1: Multidisciplinary research and evidence**


Core Activities

Co-development of the research agenda

commissioning seven thematic scoping papers on the impact of COVID 19 on education, social protection, labour rights, Violence against women, health, nutrition, and migration

- Establish a competitive Call for Proposals and put in place processes for grant management
- Support quality assurance of research processes and outputs
- Open and transparent governance

  - ii. Competitive call for proposals
  - iii. Grant management and quality assurance





# **Types of Grants:**

Agile grants for supplementing on-going projects that match the priority themes

Grant size: max grant size up to GBP £50,000 with a total amount of £200,000

Large grants are competitive open calls on priority themes

Grant size: 8 large grants of GBP £100,000 each

**Small grants** focused/ niche work on emerging themes

• Grant size of GBP £20,000-25,000



# **Priority themes**





CLEAR will focus on **social and political impact of Covid 19** (so beyond focus on the economic)

## 4 broad thematic areas:

- Poverty and vulnerability
- Service delivery, accountability and governance
- Rights of marginalised population and disadvantaged groups; and
- Innovations- technology and various policy/ programmatic









# Timeline for call and process

The call for proposals will be issued in April 2022

The closing date for competitive grants will be May 2022

Final selection and award of large grants (8 grants of £100,000) will be done by July 2022

The small grants will be reviewed on a rolling basis throughout 2022

IDS will provide grantees with guidance on -

a) reporting formats; b) ethical review process ; c) safeguarding; d) dispute resolution between IDS and grantees.

The **criteria for selecting of partners** will include: an assessment of expertise, networks, credibility and ability to manage substantial funds and shared values.




# **CLEAR Components**

Core Activities

- Support stakeholder engagement and production of policy relevant outputs
- Establish thematic working groups to facilitate learning between grantees working on similar themes and support methodological innovation
- Synthesis of lessons emerging from the body of evidence generated by the CLEAR programme
